



GOULBURN GOLF CLUB

Function Information

Please find listed conditions, explanations and details that will assist you to plan your function. We would be happy to clarify any other queries you may have.

1. A deposit of \$100 is required to secure the function room. This is fully refundable provided the room is left in a reasonable state & no damage has occurred.
2. Cancellations will be accepted without loss of deposit up to four weeks prior to the event.
3. The organiser of the function must be a member of the Club, Social membership is \$10.
4. No food or drink, apart from celebratory cakes, may be brought onto the premises due to licensing laws. Due to our health regulations we are unable to allow any leftover food from functions to be taken off the premises.
5. 18th birthday parties are permitted at the discretion of the Manager. A non-refundable deposit of \$150 is required and a bond of \$500 which is fully refundable provided no damage has occurred and the venue is left in an acceptable state. Only a limited number of people under 18 years will be permitted to attend. The Goulburn Golf Club will organise Security Guards at the expense of the Host.
6. 21st birthday parties require a bond of \$200 which is fully refundable provided no damage has occurred and the venue is left in an acceptable state.
7. Full payment for functions must be made either prior to the function or on the day of the function unless prior arrangements have been made.
8. For functions with set menus, confirmation of approximate numbers must be made one week before the function. Final numbers must be confirmed no later than the day before a function. This is the number you will be charged for.
9. For functions where guests order from the bistro menu linen tablecloths can be provided at a cost of 40c per head.
10. Organisers of functions are financially responsible for any damage to their property or that of Goulburn Golf Club.

Organisers of functions will at all times be responsible for the conduct of their guests. All club internal rules must be strictly adhered to i.e. dress and standard of behaviour.
