an immovable obstruction on the same putting green (e.g. an artificial hole plug or wire netting protecting a damaged area). Rule 24-2b (iii).

- If a player's ball lies on the putting green they may take line of play relief from an abnormal ground condition on the same putting green (e.g. casual water or ground under repair). Rule 25-1b (iii).
- Many courses have immovable obstructions, such as sprinkler heads, just off the putting green. In such circumstances, it is fairly common for Committees to introduce a **Local Rule** that permits line of play relief, without penalty, for players' balls that lie within two club-lengths of an immovable obstruction that is located within two club-lengths of the putting green.

This one comes up a lot, so we can drive it home once more:

Line of Play

There is no line of play relief from immovable obstructions that are off the putting green. Relief under Rule 24-2 is only available when an immovable obstruction interferes with the player's lie, stance or the area of their intended swing. Below are the limited circumstances when a player may take line of play relief:

- If a player's ball lies on the putting green, they may take line of play relief from
